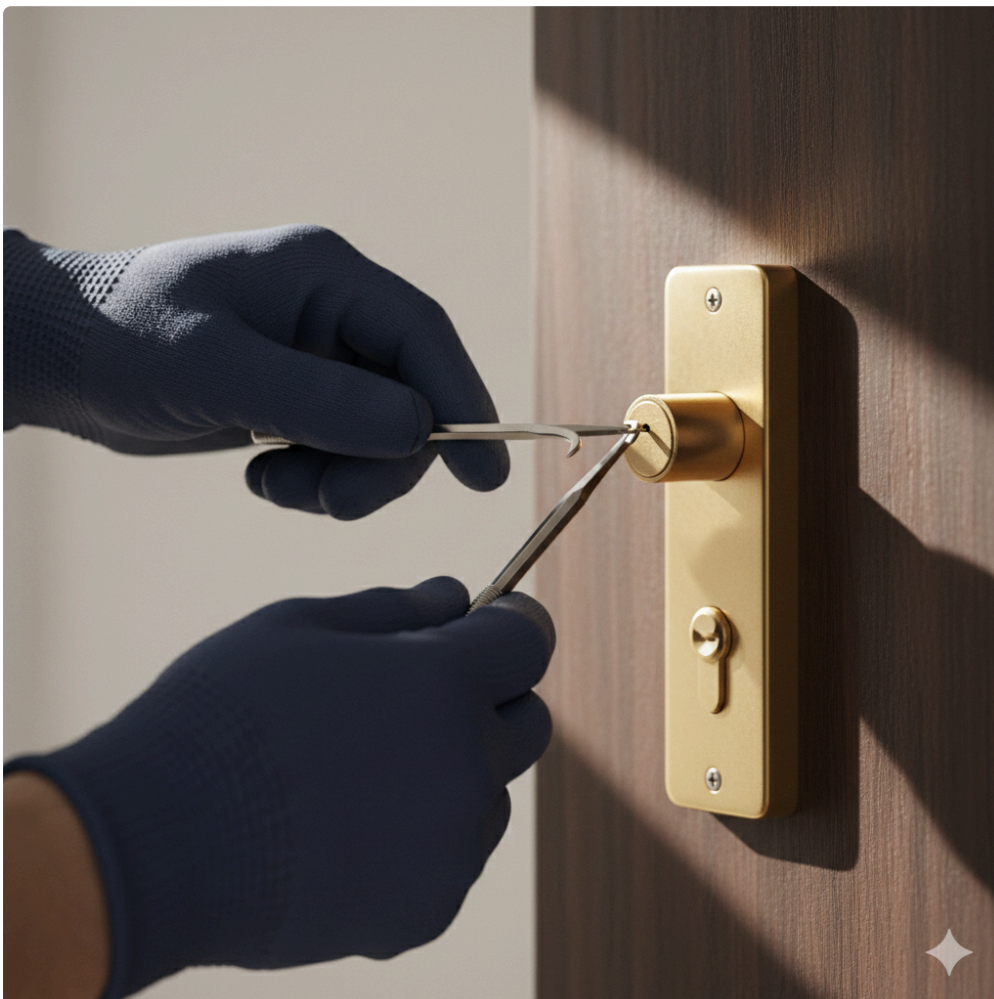
What Orlando drivers usually need first
