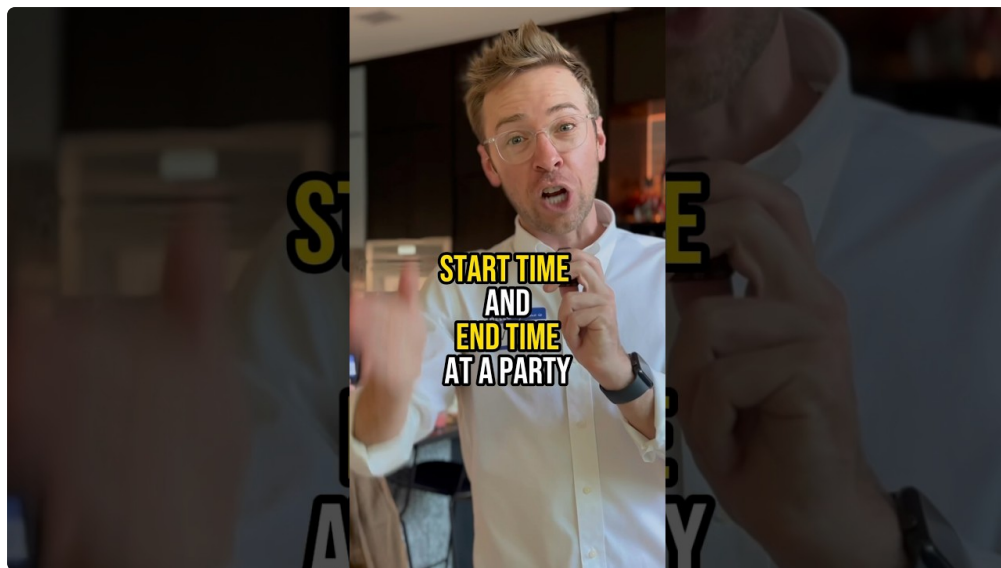


How to Contract a Celebration Expert for Only Portions of the Process
