2. The Split-Bet Strategy

- **Strategy:** Place 2 bets of equal size. Set the vehicle cash-out on the first bet to a low-to-moderate level (e.g., 2.00 x) to secure a return of the overall preliminary stake. Let the second bet run by hand to go after higher multipliers (10x, 20x, or more).
