When the ceiling is clearly wild, I use a stepped mindset. The cabinet carcass stops 1 to 2 inches shy, then a paint-grade fascia bridges the remaining bit, scribed and caulked. The joint becomes an intentional show, not an coincidence. On stain-grade custom woodwork, you won't caulk, so your tolerance demands to be tighter and your scribe thicker. I like low-profile LED strips tucked into shallow valances on the peak entrance side. Warm white around 2700 to 3000 K retains the room from feeling scientific. For a kitchen, I circumvent setting drivers in the cupboard in which warm and cooking moisture stay. An adjacent pantry, basement get entry to, or the sink base as a rule gives me a groovy, serviceable house for the drivers with a hidden conduit as much as the best valance.

HVAC is the opposite quiet occupant of tall equipped-ins. If the wall has a return or grant, plan around it early. I actually have built bookcases with included go back grilles set into the toe kick and a plenum at the back of the decrease circumstances to avert airflow unfastened. For a provide that lands desirable wherein a cabinet wants to reside, I make bigger a duct using the cupboard with a carried out sign up face. Carcasses do the heavy lifting; face frames and doorways are the smile. In tall runs, I determine ingredients and joinery that live top over peak. For paint-grade, 3/4 inch plywood with hardwood face frames resists racking. On a nine or 10 foot unit, I double up the lower back panel or add vertical to come back stiffeners, quite if shelves will elevate a hundred plus pounds of books or cookware.

Depth affects relief. Library shelves at eleven inches hinder paperbacks neat. Cookbooks prefer 12 to thirteen inches. I will pretty much recess the bottom section between studs to retailer an inch or two, or upload shallow edge returns that trick the eye.

Hardware performs double duty. Discreet facet pulls up high are advantageous if most use takes place at chest height. On topmost doorways, move larger or desire pulls possible hook with a finger from a step stool. I avoid push latches on ceiling-top doors. Another time, a pantry construct appeared common until eventually the surface dropped three/4 inch across eight feet. Adjustable ft saved the day. We leveled the bottom, skinned the toe with a scribed board, and no person ever knew. If we had set boxes straight to the flooring, doorways might have certainly not lined up and the install could have study crooked ceaselessly.
