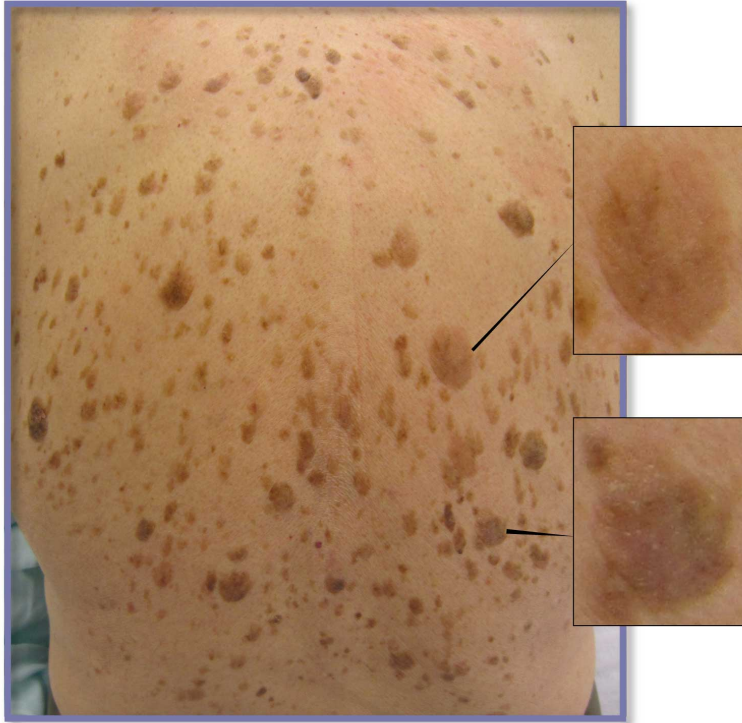


SEBORRHEIC KERATOSIS



Seborrheic keratoses are benign, beige-brown papules and plaques that have a "stuck-on" appearance.

They can mimic **squamous cell carcinoma (SCC)** but (unlike actinic keratosis) are not a SCC precursor.

Papules are smaller and often connected to conditions like acne or dermatitis, while nodules are deep and might suggest cysts or even more dangerous problems.
