What is Crazy Time?

At its core, Crazy Time is a live casino game constructed around a giant, vertical 52-segment wheel. The game is hosted by a live, energetic speaker who spins the wheel, interacts with the audience by means of live chat, and guides players through the different sectors.

What sets Crazy Time apart from basic wheel video games (like *Dream Catcher*) is the inclusion of a top slot positioned directly above the main wheel. With every spin, the top slot spins concurrently, generating a random multiplier for a specific bet spot. If the wheel stops on that spot and a bonus or number is multiplied, gamers can win huge payments.

Understanding the Wheel Segments

The 52 sections on the Crazy Time wheel are divided into numbers (which pay basic prize money) and benefit rounds (which activate minigames). Understanding the circulation of these sectors is important for managing bankrolls and understanding the video game's volatility.

The Number Bets

Gamers can place bets on four different numbers: **1, 2, 5, and 10**. Each number corresponds to its payout multiplier if the wheel lands on it.

- **1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel (greatest frequency, most affordable payout of 1:1).
- **2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel (payment of 2:1).
- **5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel (payout of 5:1).
- **10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel (payment of 10:1).

The Bonus Rounds

The true excitement of Crazy Time depends on its four reward rounds. These inhabit a combined overall of 9 sectors on the wheel, making them rarer to strike, but greatly more gratifying.

1. **Coin Flip** (4 sectors on the wheel)
2. **Pachinko** (2 segments on the wheel)
3. **Cash Hunt** (2 sections on the wheel)
4. **Crazy Time** (1 segment on the wheel)

The Four Thrilling Bonus Rounds Explained

When the wheel stops on a bonus offer section, all players who put a bet on that particular perk round are carried to a different, immersive set (or enhanced reality screen) to participate.

1. Coin Flip

The simplest of the bonus offer rounds, Coin Flip includes a coin with a Red side and a Blue side. Each side is designated a random multiplier by the video game system before the flip. The host pulls a lever to flip the coin, and whichever side lands deal with up awards the player that corresponding multiplier. If multipliers are low, a "Rescue Flip" can sometimes be activated for a second possibility.

2. Pachinko

Motivated by the traditional Japanese arcade video game, the Pachinko bonus offer round features an enormous wall filled with physical pegs. The game host drops a bitz.io puck from the top of the board, and it bounces arbitrarily down through the pegs till it lands in one of the multiplier zones at the bottom.

- If the puck lands on a **"Double"** worth, all multipliers at the bottom of the wall double, and the puck is dropped once again for even greater stakes.

3. Money Hunt

Money Hunt is an interactive shooting gallery minigame. Gamers exist with an enormous screen showing 108 random multipliers concealed behind various symbols (such as a cactus, a target, or a chef's hat).

- Gamers use an on-screen crosshair to objective and "shoot" their chosen sign before the timer goes out.
- As soon as time ends, all signs expose their covert multipliers, and players receive the multiplier connected to their chosen target.

4. Crazy Time

The crown gem of the video game is the Crazy Time perk round. Gamers stroll through a red door into a dynamic, virtual wonderland including a huge, 64-segment mega wheel.

- Before the wheel is spun, players need to pick one of three flappers: **Green, Blue, or Yellow.**

- The wheel is spun, and whichever multiplier the selected flapper points to is awarded to the player.
- Similar to Pachinko, this wheel includes **"Double"** and **"Triple"** segments. If the flapper arrive at one of these, the multipliers on the wheel boost, and the wheel is spun again-- potentially pushing payments as much as the video game's optimum limitation of **20,000 x**.

Key Strategies for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is fundamentally a video game of chance powered by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and a physical wheel, gamers frequently adopt particular wagering strategies to manage their threat and extend their playtime.

Popular Betting Approaches

- **The Safe & Steady Strategy (Number Betting):**
 - Focus primarily on banking on numbers 1 and 2, while placing small hedge bets on benefit rounds. This technique yields frequent, smaller sized wins and keeps the bankroll stable.
- **The Bonus Hunter Strategy:**
 - Place bets specifically on the 4 bonus offer rounds (Coin Flip, Pachinko, Cash Hunt, and Crazy Time). This is a high-volatility strategy created for gamers who want to experience the minigames as typically as possible, accepting that they may experience dry spells of non-bonus spins.
- **The Balanced Spread:**
 - Cover a mix of numbers and all 4 perk rounds proportionally. This ensures that nearly every spin of the wheel yields some kind of return or triggers a feature.

Necessary Tips for Beginners

- **Set a Budget:** Decide on a set bankroll before visiting and never chase losses.
- **Understand RTP:** Keep in mind that various bets have a little various Return to Player portions. Number bets typically offer a higher analytical RTP than bonus offer bets, but benefit bets provide the excitement of massive multipliers.
- **Enjoy the Show:** Crazy Time is designed as home entertainment initially. Deal with the prospective winnings as a reward to the interactive, game-show experience.
