Fire and panic devices deserve the same attention as the front door

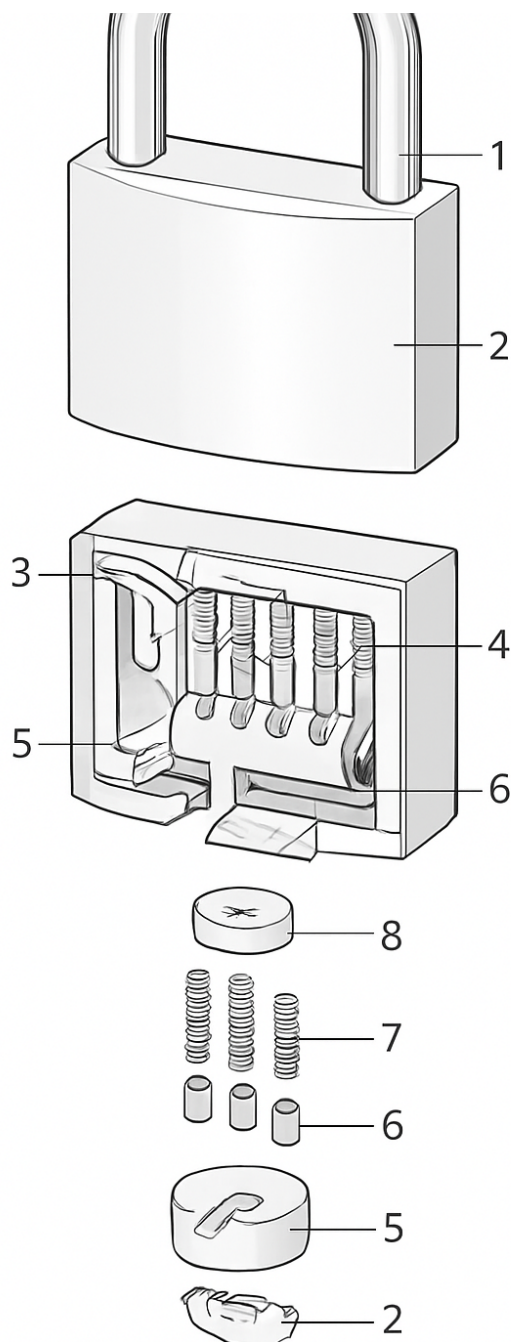
