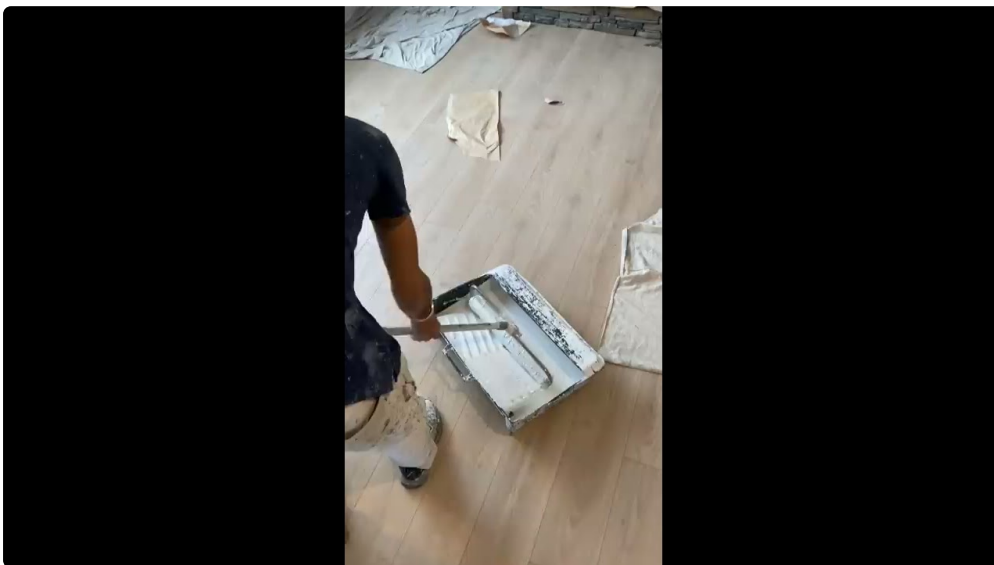

We removed 28 doorways and 12 drawers, wiped clean, deglossed, and spot-primed with a tannin blocker wherein obligatory. Frames got a bonding primer and a top-construct surfacer. We sanded profiles with foam

pads and shot two topcoats of satin urethane. Doors were sprayed flat in the shop with the similar manner. Hardware holes have been filled and re-drilled to replace from 3-inch pulls to 5-inch, which required a jig and persistence to hold traces directly.

From arrival to very last wipe-down took 8 working days. At day 3 after rehang, the finish felt dry however we nonetheless instructed easy use for more than one weeks. Six months later the customer also known as, now not with a criticism, yet to schedule ceiling portray providers inside the adjacent kin room given that the cupboards made the ancient ceiling appear drained. That is the ripple impression a smartly-finished cupboard conclude has on a dwelling house.
