Red dust trips in on shoes and paw pads, desert air dries fibers, and kids in some way grind Goldfish crumbs into places no vacuum can reach. St George homes ask a lot of their floorings. 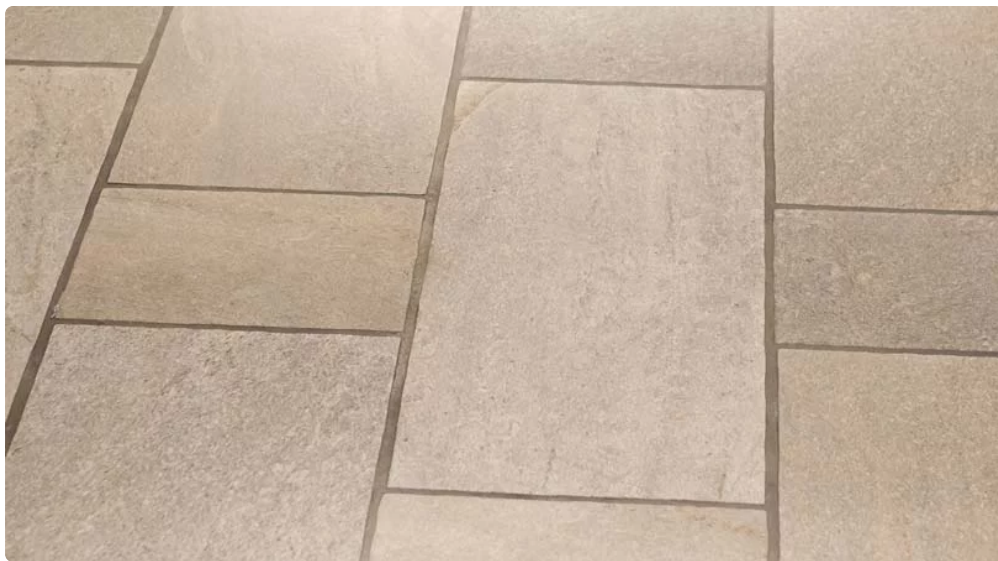
5. Animal treatment that addresses the pad, not simply the pile
