Why car key work is not the same as house lock work

Even a simple lost car key can become a programming issue if the vehicle uses transponder or smart key technology. It may involve extraction, programming, or a decision about whether ignition repair or replacement is actually needed.

This is where mobile service earns its value, because towing a vehicle for a key problem is often more expensive and more disruptive than solving the issue on site. That is also why people often prefer a locksmith who can explain the likely path before starting the work.

Why business owners care about access control
