

A faulty garage door track can quickly turn a routine opening into a potential hazard. If your overhead garage door is noisy, jerks as it moves, comes off its track, or halts midway, the problem may involve the track, garage door rollers, springs, cables, or opener. Repairing the Track Compared With Garage Door Replacement
