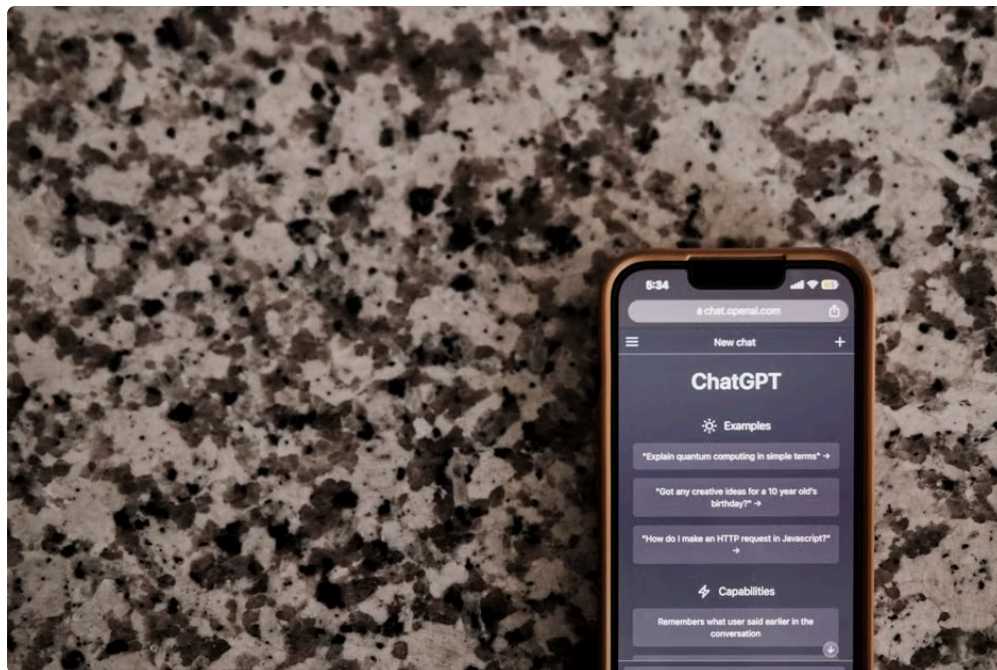
What to do next: Enjoy the free plan as much as you want. If you need faster responses and priority access, then consider upgrading to ChatGPT Plus separately.

Trials Are Targeted Campaigns, Invites, or Eligibility Programs

When OpenAI offers a trial of ChatGPT Plus, it's usually part of a targeted promotion, an invite-only program, or an eligibility-based campaign. These special trials let certain users try ChatGPT Plus features for free temporarily to gather feedback or incentivize upgrades.

- These trials are not standard or guaranteed for all users.
- They may require providing payment details upfront to prevent abuse.
- Once the trial ends, the user's card is charged the \$20 monthly subscription fee if they don't cancel.

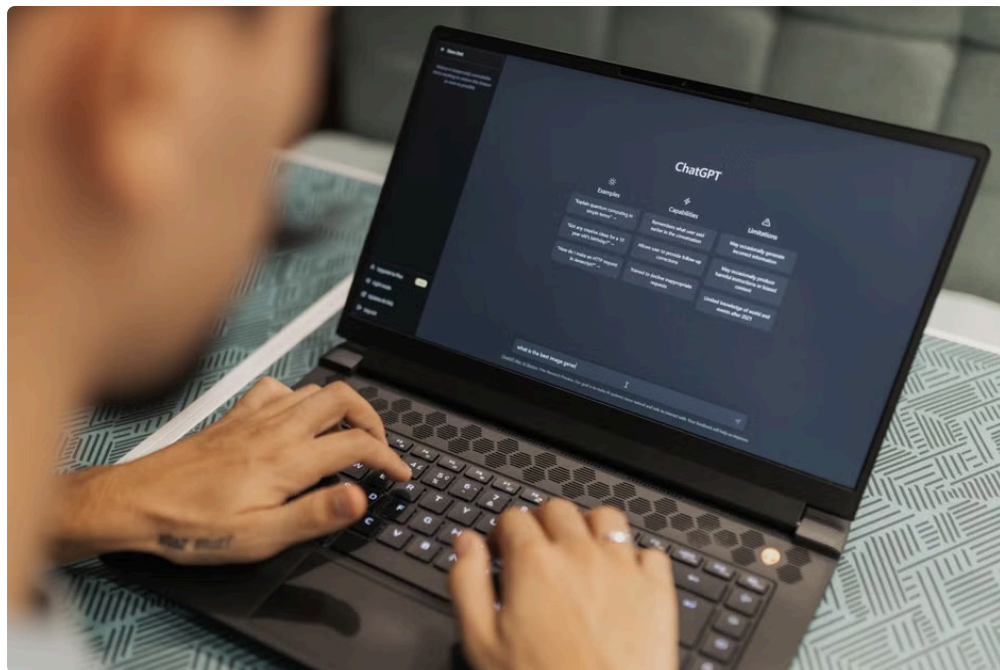
Credit Card Requirement Depends on Offer and Can Auto-Renew
