How Transactions Work: Steam API and P2P Trading

In the past, CS2 gambling websites utilized bots that directly traded with players by means of Steam accounts. Today, many platforms use **Peer-to-Peer (P2P) systems**.

3. The site credits the depositor's account balance once the trade is verified.
