

Garage Door Repair Services in Los Angeles

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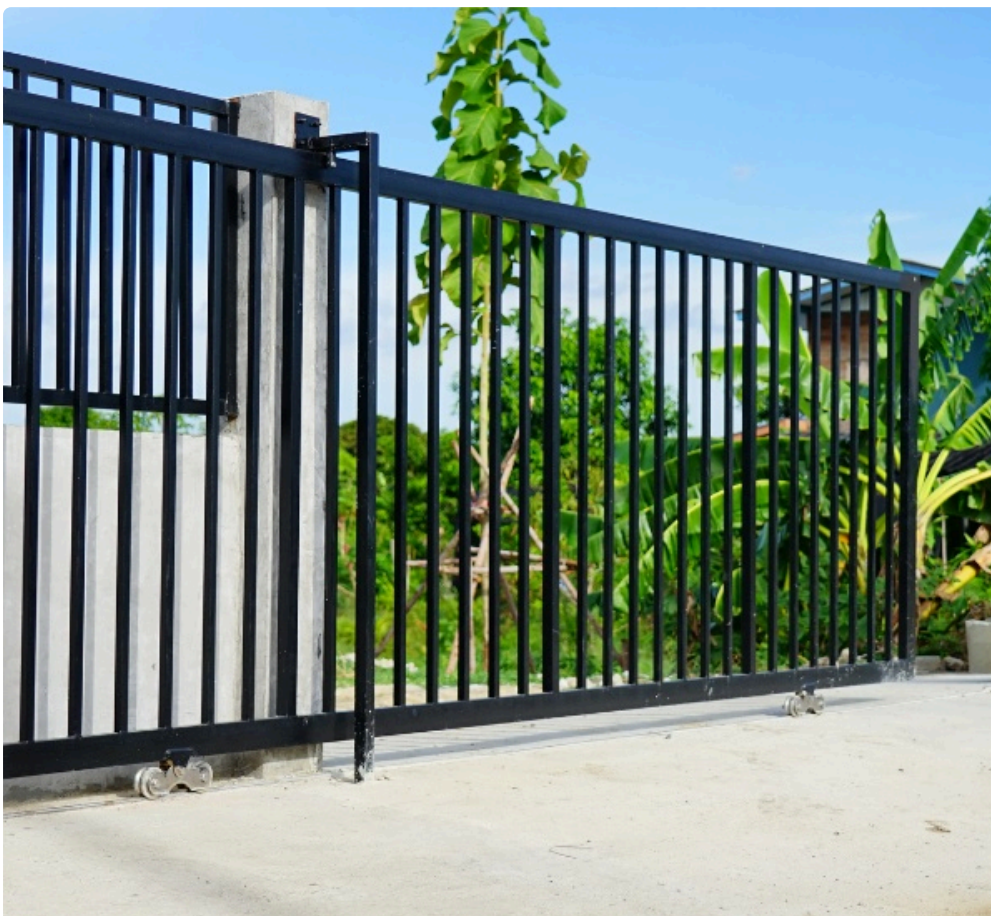

Damaged garage door rollers can cause a rattling garage door, rough movement, or excessive vibration. Nylon rollers may lower noise, while steel rollers can be useful in some heavy-duty applications. The garage door track should also be checked for loose fasteners, bends, gaps, and alignment problems. A bent garage door track can cause the door to jam or leave the rollers partially out of position.

Garage door replacement may be more appropriate when several panels are damaged, the frame is warped, the door is badly rusted, or compatible replacement sections are unavailable. Opener and Remote-Control Failures

Safety sensors, also called photo-eye sensors, are positioned near the floor on both sides of the door. When they are blocked, dirty, damaged, or misaligned, the door may reverse or refuse to close. Never bypass these sensors. They are designed to prevent the door from closing on a person, pet, or object.

For an older or unreliable unit, a smart garage door opener can provide app controls, activity alerts, and integration with compatible home systems. Ask about the garage door opener installation cost, drive type, electrical requirements, warranty, and whether the existing mounting hardware can be reused.
