

Most washing machines last 10 to 14 years, but that lifespan assumes regular maintenance and fortunate component survival. How no-guarantee repairs create repeat costs in Sacramento's climate

Understanding why unwarranted labor leaves you open to double spending

The average washer repair costs between \$250 and \$500, depending on the failed component. A drum bearing replacement, pump failure, or control board repair each falls in that range. If a technician completes that work with no guarantee—meaning they make no promise that the repair will hold for a specified period—you are legally responsible for any repeat failure, even if it stems from the technician's error or negligence. This unwarranted liability is the defining risk. Homeowners think a repair is finished; they pay the invoice; they expect the machine to work. 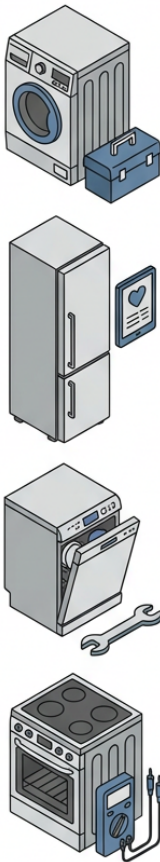
