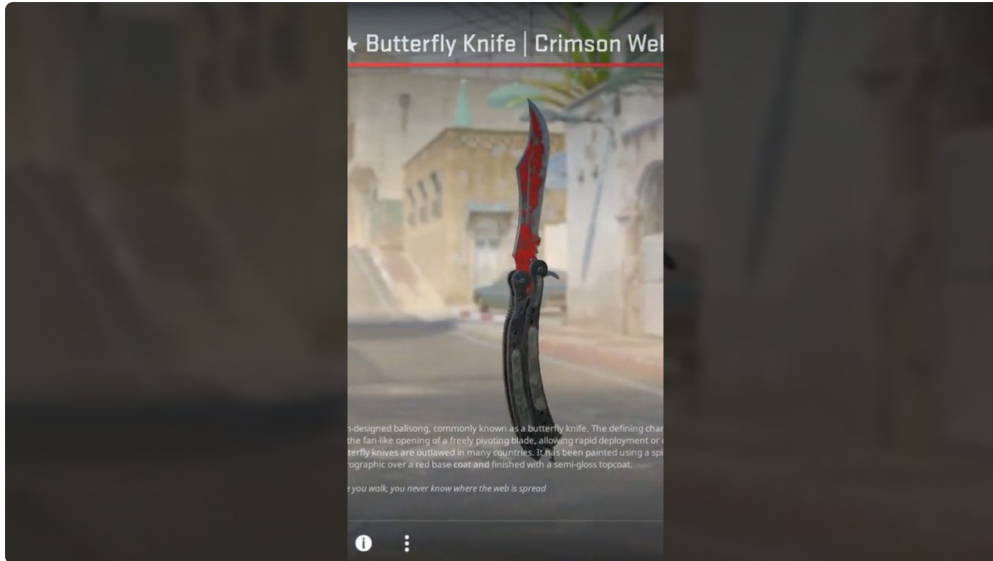


The Ins and Outs of Counter-Strike: Global Offensive Case Opening

1. What Is a CS: GO Case?

In Counter-Strike: Global Offensive (CS: GO), "cases" are locked containers that can be opened with an unique key. 4.1 Cost Overview

- **Case rate:** varies, typically between £ 0.50 and £ 3.00 on the marketplace.
- **Secret rate:** fixed at £ 2.50 (GBP) from the in-game store.

Therefore, the total cost to open a single case typically ranges from **£ 3.00 to £ 5.50**.

4.2 Expected Return

7.1 What are the specific odds of getting a Rare Special Item?
