- **Lack of Community Presence:** Check platforms like Trustpilot, Reddit (e.g., r/csgobetting), and Twitter. If a site has an overwhelmingly unfavorable track record or is entirely unidentified, it is best prevented.

Best Practices for Safe Wagering
