- **Protect Your Steam Credentials:** Never log into your Steam account on a suspicious pop-up window. Constantly utilize the main OpenID login provided straight by Valve.
- **Set a Budget:** Treat case battles as entertainment, not a trustworthy source of earnings. Never bet more than you can comfortably manage to lose.

A "Provably Fair" system utilizes cryptography to prove that the outcome of a case battle was predetermined and might not be modified by the website operator *after* you positioned your bet. You can verify the fairness of each round using the supplied server seeds and client seeds.

5. Can I get VAC prohibited for utilizing case field of honor?

Using third-party trading and case-opening sites does not straight result in a Valve Anti-Cheat (VAC) restriction. However, Valve sometimes updates its regards to service or prohibits API secrets related to automated trading bots, which can temporarily interrupt your ability to trade skins.
