- **The Moonshot:** Ignoring small multipliers totally and aiming exclusively for high numbers (10x, 50x, or more). This requires a big bankroll and extreme perseverance.

 - Navigate to the **Installed Files** tab and click **Verify stability of game files**.
- **Update Graphics Drivers:**
 - Visit NVIDIA GeForce Experience or AMD Adrenalin to download the current steady motorists. Carry out a clean installation if possible.
- **Lower In-Game Settings:**
