2. Energy Synergy

- **Molotovs/Incendiaries:** Used to clear tight angles (like "Newell" on Inferno or "Banana") and delay opponent presses.
- **Smokes:** Block sniper lanes and isolate bomb websites during execution.

3. Map Control and Defaulting

- Expanding across the map requires the CTs to expose their positioning.
