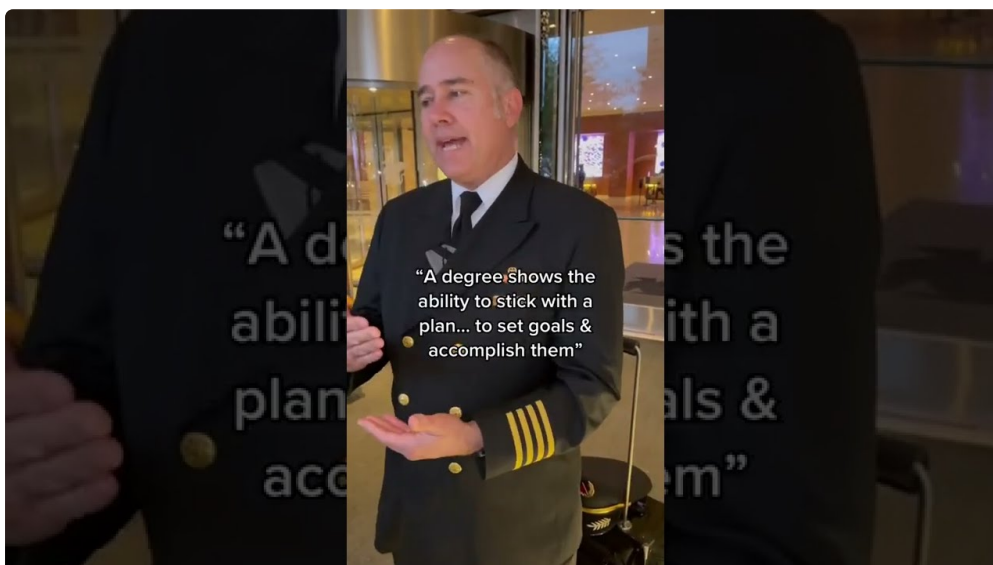
If you want a straightforward way to evaluate whether you are making use of the portal effectively, take note of end results, not activity. Ask yourself:
