Natural stone dislikes thin strips, quartz tolerates them yet hates heat, compact sintered surfaces withstand stains however chip on sharp inner corners, and forged floor should be repaired yet actions extra with temperature. The sink's rim model, the tap layout, and the cupboard width all trade the failure modes.

When we lay out a sink commencing, I'm as concerned about what's going to turn up to the unsupported rails at the back and front as I am within the shape the buyer sees.
