Another customer chefs every day and assists in keeping cast iron at the movement. We went with rift white alrightfor the island, grain filled, then sprayed a 2K waterborne poly in satin. The perimeter cupboards have been painted in a gentle grey waterborne alkyd. The island takes abuse, wipes easy, and indicates no cup earrings.
