Advantages

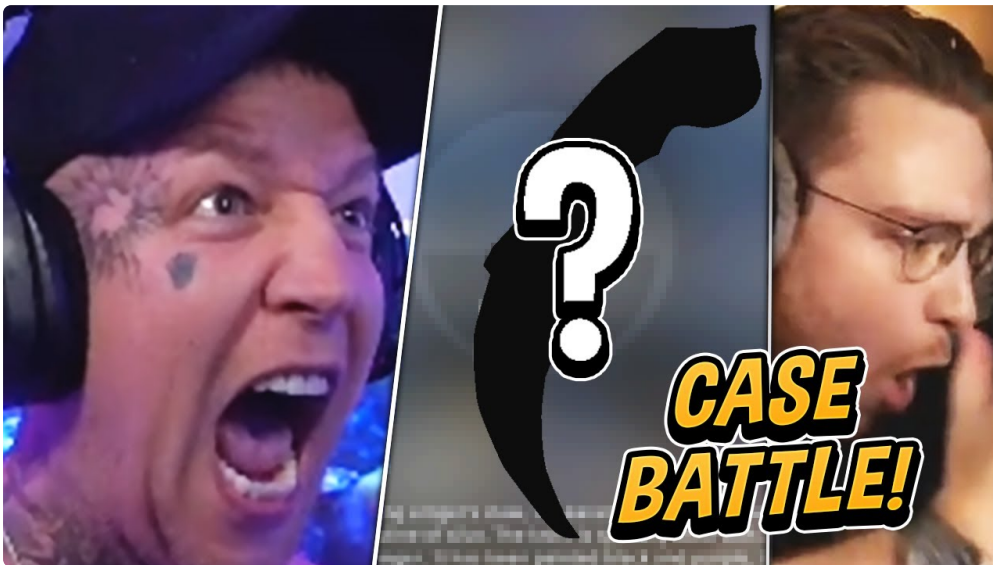
- **Social Experience**-- Players can engage through chat, watch real-time openings, and share the adventure of a rare drop.
