We checked moisture at questionable trim - readings hovered at 12 to fourteen p.c after a dry spell - then primed with a tannin-blocking off acrylic on sanded cedar. We returned-brushed two coats of a satin acrylic at the body and used a a bit slash sheen on the crown facts to save glare down less than the afternoon sunlight.

The home owner informed me later that the wonderful cash spent changed into not the paint model however the time budgeted for caulking and notice-priming at elevation. Four years on, a rapid consult with for typhoon contact-u.s.showed tight joints and regular sheen, precisely what you wish to see on a tall external.
