We back-brushed two coats of a satin acrylic at the frame and used a slightly cut back sheen on the crown info to save glare down lower than the afternoon solar.

The homeowner advised me later that the handiest payment spent become not the paint emblem but the time budgeted for caulking and notice-priming at elevation. Four years on, a speedy visit for hurricane contact-usaconfirmed tight joints and constant sheen, precisely what you need to see on a tall outside.
