

Hit and Run Accident Help in Midland TX Get somewhere safe, then call 911 or the Midland Police Department. That's the first move after a hit and run, even if the other car is long gone and your injuries seem minor. A police report creates an official record of what happened, and your insurance company will likely want to see it before paying on an uninsured motorist claim. If the crash happened on a county road or a state highway outside city limits, the sheriff's office or a DPS trooper may respond instead. Drivers who [Midland Car Accident Lawyer](#) flee rarely leave without a trace. Write down everything you remember about the vehicle as soon as you can: color, make, damage, direction of travel and even a partial plate. Look around for witnesses and ask for their phone numbers before they drive away. Then think about cameras. Along Big Spring Street, Loop 250 north and the shopping areas near Midland Park Mall, many businesses have security cameras aimed toward the road. Gas stations, banks and restaurants in downtown Midland and east Midland often do too. That footage may be recorded over within days, so asking quickly matters. Check your own phone and car too. A dash camera, or a photo you snapped without thinking, can hold more detail than you remember. If the driver is never found, your own policy may still help. Texas requires insurers to offer uninsured motorist coverage, and it is included in your policy unless you rejected it in writing. That coverage can apply when a hit and run driver can't be identified, though insurers usually have conditions, such as prompt reporting. Personal injury protection, or PIP, may also cover some medical bills and lost wages regardless of who was at fault. Keep in mind that your own insurer can still push back, and a claim with your own company isn't always as smooth as people expect.

If you were hurt, missed work or the other driver's insurer is disputing fault, a lawyer usually pays for themselves.
