

No one recalls which Saturday I learned the distinction among a smartly-run group cleanup and one who limps along. I simply understand the scent of moist leaves, a handful of volunteers status around anticipating direction, and a roll off dumpster arriving forty minutes past due to a useless-end avenue that a 20-foot truck couldn't truly exit. No overflow, no indignant emails, and a comfortable hauler who mentioned, "You run a fine web page."
