2. The Reverse Martingale (Paroli System)

If the standard Martingale is too stressful, the Reverse Martingale focuses on taking advantage of winning streaks while keeping losses very little.

- **How it works:** You double your bet after every **win**, and reset to your base bet after every **loss**.
- **Goal:** Ride a hot streak of 3 to 4 wins in a row, then squander and reset. This safeguards your core balance while letting the house's money trip throughout a streak.

3. The Low Multiplier Auto-Cashout Strategy (Conservative)

This technique prioritizes consistency and durability over huge, life-changing payouts.

- **How it works:** You set an **Auto-Cashout** at an extremely conservative multiplier, generally between **1.15 x** and **1.30 x**.
