Pointer: Look for platforms that release a "provably reasonable" hash for each battle. This enables gamers to independently confirm that the outcome was not modified after the truth.

4. Types of Case Battle Giveaways

- **Scheduled Giveaways**-- Occur at a set time each day (e.g., 8 PM UTC). Players should register before the start.
- **Instantaneous Giveaways**-- Randomly set off after any case battle concludes; winners are drawn immediately from the pool of participants.
- **Community-Funded Giveaways**-- A portion of the home's revenue is contributed to the prize swimming pool, often connected to unique events (holidays, significant CSGO updates).
