Beyond install: maintaining operations smooth

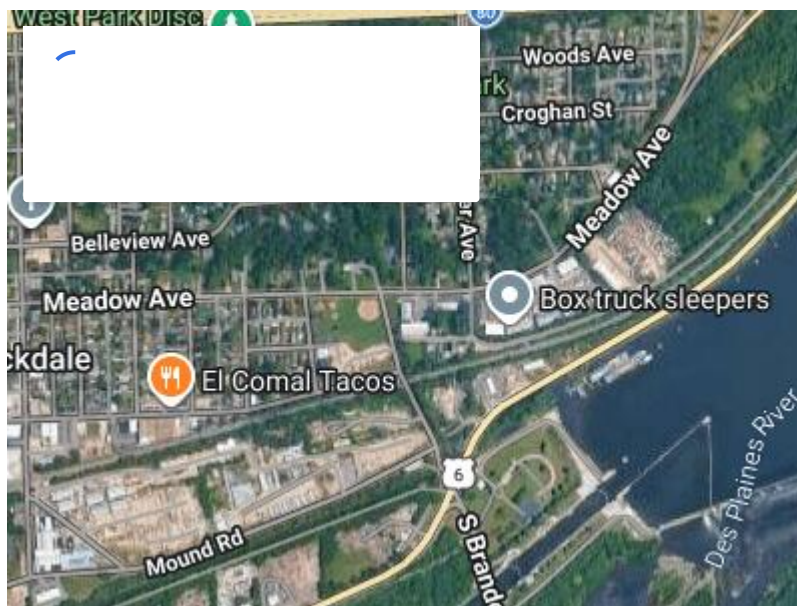
