For penguin magic, I like a rhythm that sounds playful, now not technical.

Here's the trend I use tons: mention the penguin subject matter, make a small promise, then trigger the amendment with a pause that looks like suspense.

You're now not explaining the trick. You're directing realization.

That pause is central. If you trigger the pull after which instant scramble into the monitor, you provide the audience no time to course of what simply passed off. If you trigger the pull and pause for 1/2 a breath, they recognize the world changed and their brain starts off-evolved screaming.

“Empty Hands, Penguin Surprise”: why the setup matters

Then make the audience’s task light. They deserve to understand wherein the prop change will appear. If you don’t supply them an “objective,” they’ll seem to be around the world.

The “evidence moment”

I like putting a brief affirmation line:

“I’m not cheating. My hands are just palms.”

Then you instruct the two palms quickly. It’s no longer approximately convincing a magician. It’s approximately giving the audience permission to have confidence you.

Then you do the pull at a beat you can still management. Show the outcomes good away, along with your face grew to become towards the target market, no longer down into your palms.

The response method: act barely surprised too

This sounds silly, however it’s wonderful. If you look precisely certain the whole time, the viewers thinks you planned it flawlessly. If you upload a hint of genuine marvel, their mind treats the instant as true.

You’re no longer pretending to be incompetent. You’re creating an emotional handshake between you and them.

A 2d pull trick: “The Penguin Swap”

Why it lands
