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Create a moving timeline that includes important tasks such as:

- Confirming moving-day details

Determine What Type of Moving Service You Need

Before contacting a mover, determine the type of relocation you are planning. A small local apartment move has very different requirements from a large household relocation or commercial office move.

Common moving categories include local moves, budget-focused moves, long-distance relocations, and commercial moves. Understanding the differences can help you contact companies that are equipped for your specific situation.

Build a Detailed Moving Inventory
